

PODLETS by Spencer Ogg

Reversible and collapsible Fabric Baskets. Tutorial on <https://youtu.be/laA8PIENuPM> or Spencer Ogg You Tube channel

Step 1. Cut out two pieces of fabric 10" wide and 11" long. Lining and outer.

Step 2. Cut out two pieces of medium weight stabilizer same size (or 1/2" less) and iron onto the wrong side of both pieces of fabric.

Step 3. Press down a hem on top and bottom of Both pieces....I do 3/8".

Step 4. Make sure pieces are even,

a) Fold outer in half **right sides** together matching hems.

b) Fold lining in half **wrong sides** together matching hems,

c) mark 1 3/4" up from fold(bottom) ,fold lining down at the mark. This forms the base, make sure hems are still even.

Step 5. Insert folded edge of outer inside the indent in the base of lining and then fold up the outer to one side matching all hems; secure in place. Clips are handy.

Step 6. Sew up each side. Secure each end of these seams well. Clip corners.

Step 7. Turn out the outer.

Step 8. Top stitch the top hems together. This can be decorative.
