Crazy Patch originated as a means of using every available scrap of fabric and not having any waste. It was a technique used to cover a hole in a garment or furnishing. Later it became something for the well to do to practise their embroidery techniques.

In this workshop you will make one block, approximately 20 cms square, working a few stitches to cover seams, adding some embellishments, including

ribbons, beads, buttons, lace, and anything else you would like to bring to coordinate or contrast with your choice of fabrics. The block can be used in a quilt, bag, pouch, cushions or whatever takes your fancy. Bust your stash of fabric and embellishments! I look forward to sharing a day of crazy patch with you
